Attached is the draw for the golf (morning Texas Scramble and afternoon Glue Pot Trophy) together with the field for the shooting (morning and afternoon) and the croquet. The draw for the croquet will be announced on the day. Also included are the instructions for the Presentation Dinner and Croquet match.

**Golf: Sponsored by IMCD UK Ltd**

All the golfing activities start in the Golf Centre, which has its own car park. The visitors changing room and the golf shop are in the Golf Centre and the golf coordinator for the day is Mr John Bastock, who will be available in the bar area in the golf centre at Hawkstone Park Hotel and Golf Centre. Players are required to bring their own equipment and buggies are available for hire from the sports shop – please call 01948 841775 to reserve. Please report to the Terrace Bar/Restaurant in the Golf Centre at least 30 minutes before your tee time (morning and/or afternoon) to pick up your cards etc. You need to be at the first tee 10 minutes before your tee time.

**Morning - Texas Scramble on the Championship Course (9 holes)**

Registration with tea, coffee and bacon sandwiches at 08.30 in the Hawkstone Park Golf Centre. The terrace bar at the golf centre is open from 08:00 and the first tee time is 09.00.

**Afternoon – The Glue Pot Trophy on the Hawkstone Course (18 holes).**

Includes the Nearest the Pin (12<sup>th</sup>) and the longest drive (18<sup>th</sup>) Registration for the afternoon golf is from 11.30am. Lunch will be available from 12.00 – 13:00. Any morning shooters playing afternoon golf should take their lunch at the golf centre. The first Tee Time is 12.30

**Shooting: Sponsored by Newport Industries Ltd.**

Our competitions take place at the West Midlands Shooting Ground, Hodnet, Market Drayton, TF9 3LH. Registration with tea, coffee and bacon sandwiches is at 9.15am at the WMSG. The day includes safety training and tuition and all equipment. Directions: at the Hodnet roundabout (A52/A422) exit onto A53 for approximately 1.5 miles, taking the 3rd country road on the right, after ½ mile, take the first right and then 1st gate left. <http://www.wmsg.co.uk>

Morning - Air Rifle, 22 Rifle, Centre Fire, Multi Calibre (4 shots per person).

- Participants for the morning events should arrive at the West Midlands Shooting Ground Club House for registration, coffee and bacon baps from 09:15
- Events will commence promptly at 10.00 for the morning participants, and teams are listed in this document.
- Afternoon participants should register at 12:15 when lunch will be served for all registered participants at 12:30 prompt
- The afternoon Shooting Competition (Glue Gun Trophy) will commence at 13.15 prompt and teams are listed in this document.
- The final 4-man flush to finish the day will be held after all teams have completed the 50 Clay competition at approximately 15:30



As soon as the 4 Man Flush is complete the shooting participants should make their way to Hawkstone Park Hotel for the Croquet competition and/or dinner.

**Handicap Allowance: Team of four = 1/10th of combined handicaps, Team of three = 1/8th of combined handicaps**

- All players tee off on all holes.
- **A minimum of 2 tee shots per player must be used for teams of 4 and 3 tee shots for teams of three.**
- Nominated Team Captain then selects the drive to be used and marks the position with a tee peg (not nearer the hole). The other players then retrieve their balls.
- All players then play within 300mm (12 inches) of the tee peg, not nearer the hole, in any order.
- A ball may be placed on the fairway, but must be dropped from any other area, including hazards.
- The above method of play is followed until the green is reached.
- On the green the same method applies. The ball chosen is marked and all players putt from that spot in any order.
- Each player marks the ball after putting. Play continues from each position until the ball is holed.
- The gross score for each hole should be marked on the score card against the player whose tee shot was used, e.g. A, B, C or D.
